CHIEF COMPLAINT
Persistent chest pain and shortness of breath for the past two weeks.

HISTORY OF PRESENT ILLNESS
Mr. Bertrand is a 52-year-old male with a history of hypertension and hyperlipidemia who presents with intermittent chest pain that started two weeks ago.
